

Mozilla Firefox Installation and Configuration

Install Mozilla Firefox 1.x

Exclude Quality Feedback Agent

Stop IE from requesting to be the Default Browser

To prevent Internet Explorer 6.0 from nagging you about being the default browser, put the following registry key into your registry tweaks:

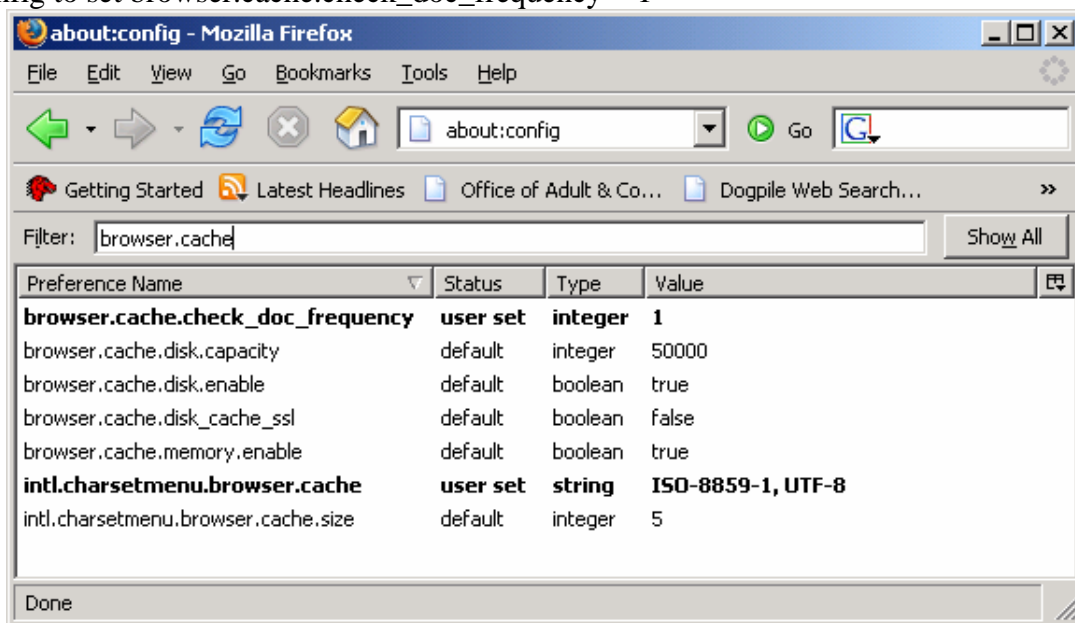
CODE

```
[HKEY_CURRENT_USER\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Internet Explorer\Main]
"Check_Associations"="no"
```

Configure Mozilla Firefox

Configure browser.cache.check_doc_frequency

Use about:config to set browser.cache.check_doc_frequency = 1

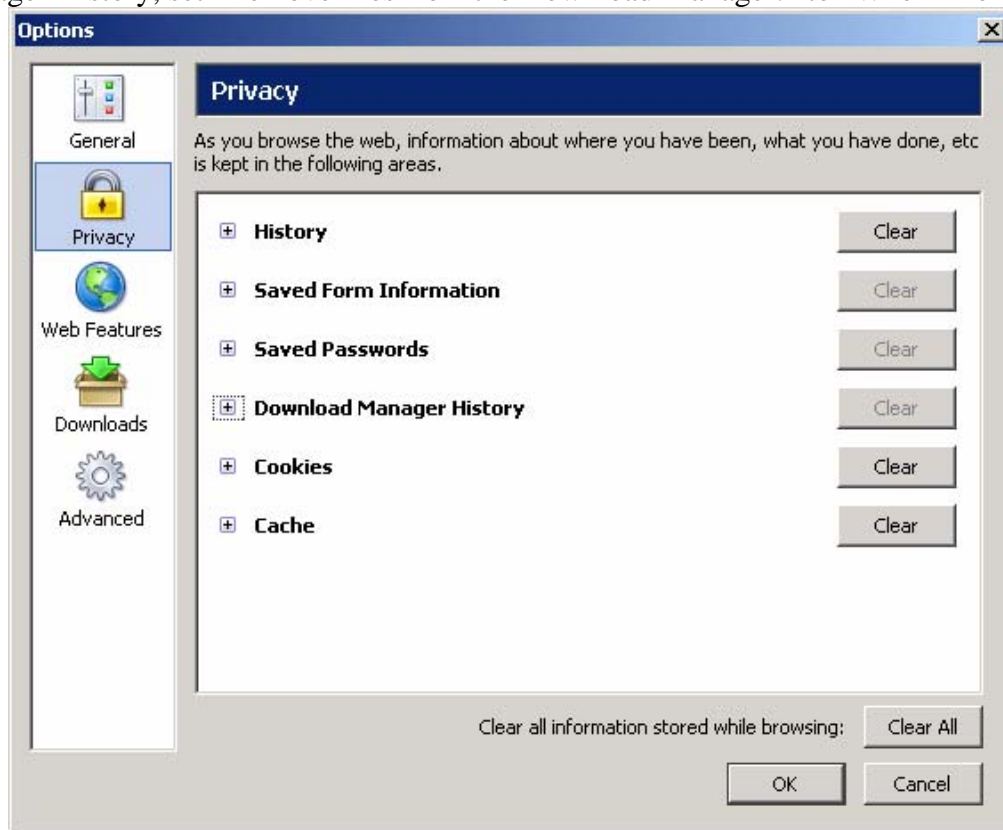


Tools > Options: Privacy Settings

Disable: Saved Form Information

Disable: Saved Passwords

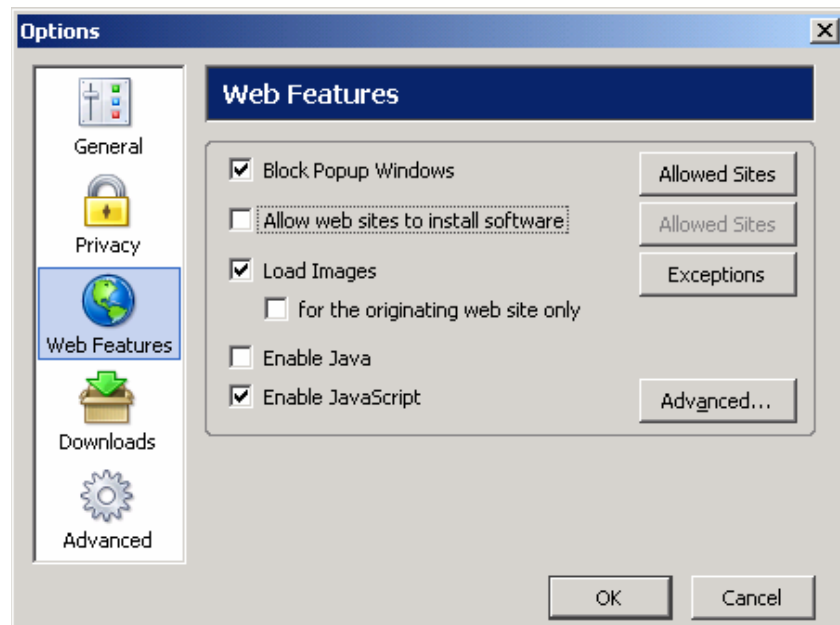
Download Manager History, set “Remove files from the Download Manager:” to “When Firefox exits”



Tools > Options: Web Features

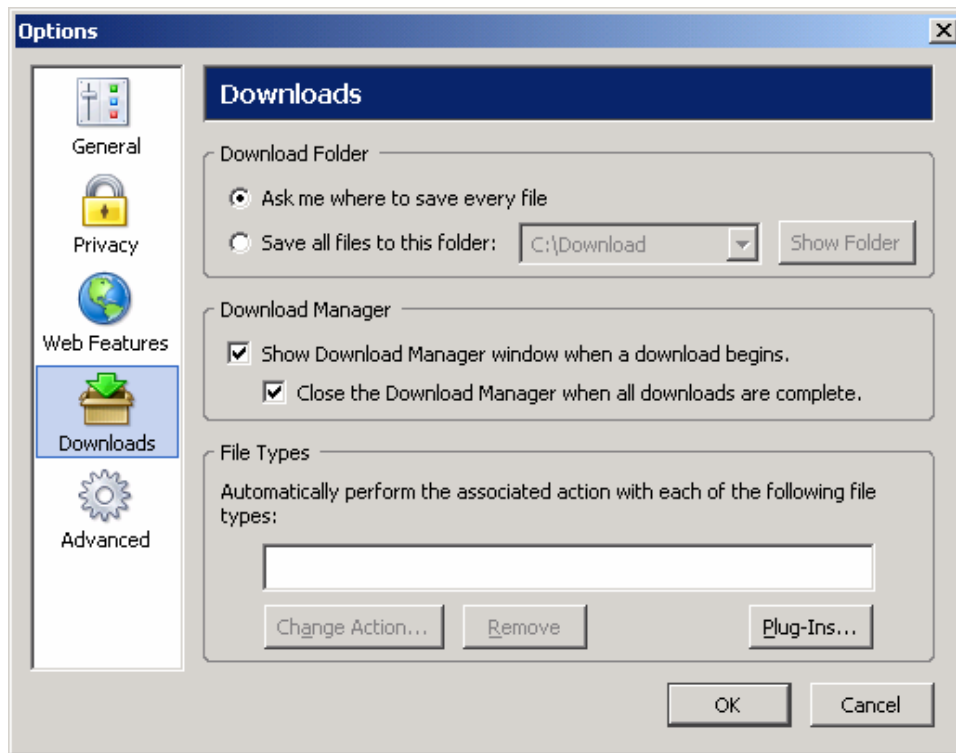
Turn off: Allow web sites to install software

Turn off: Enable Java



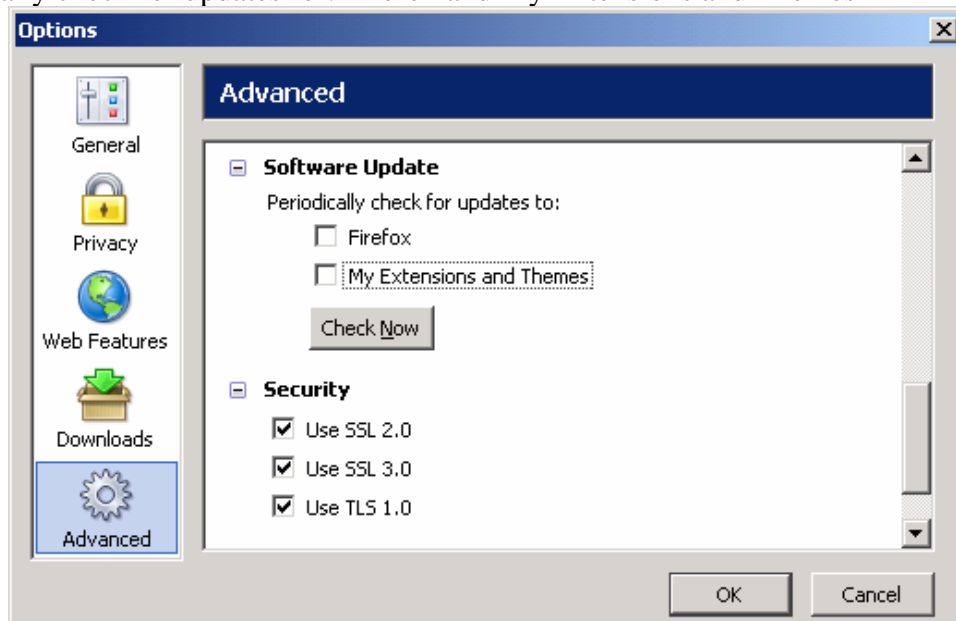
Tools > Options: Downloads

Set “Save all files to this folder:” to C:\Download. Then enable “Ask me where to save every file”
Download Manager: (see image below)



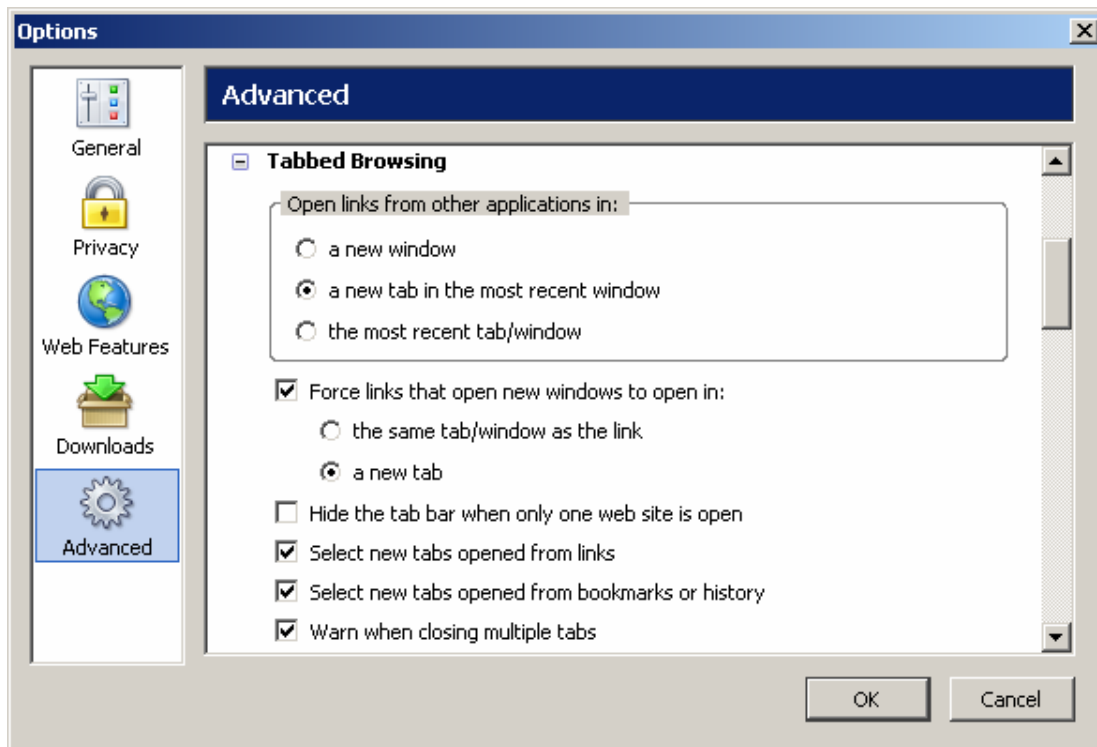
Tools > Options: Advanced

Turn off: Periodically check for updates for: Firefox and My Extensions and Themes



Tabbed Browsing

Configure Tabbed Browsing, after you've created the *user.js* file and moved the profile. Then configure as the below image indicates:



Move the Cache to C:\Temp\cache.mozilla

Use `about:cache` to see where the profile is stored, i.e. (C:\Documents and Settings\Admin\Application Data\Mozilla\Firefox\Profiles\xxxxxxx.default\Cache)

Empty the cache and change the location of the Cache, before moving the profile.

Move Profile to C:\My Documents\Mozilla Firefox\Profiles\

1. Exit from Mozilla Firefox
2. Modify `profiles.ini` to point to the new location

```
IsRelative=0
Path=C:\My Documents\Mozilla Firefox\Profiles\xxxxxxx.default
```
3. Move the Profiles directory to the new location

Location of `profiles.ini` under Windows XP:

C:\Documents and Settings**<User Name>**\Application Data\Mozilla\Firefox**profiles.ini**
(The Application Data directory is probably hidden)

Toolbar

Add “New Tab” button to the left of the home button on the toolbar.

Add “Print” button to the right of the Go button on the toolbar.

Upgrading Mozilla Firefox 1.0 to 1.0.1

1. Uninstall Firefox 1.0, say okay to delete C:\Program Files\Mozilla Firefox\ directory.
2. Install Firefox 1.0.1. (1.0.1 will use to settings and profile.ini from the 1.0 installation.)
